

PATTERSON CYPRESS SAWMILL FESTIVAL

Dear Crafters and Artists:

The Patterson Cypress Sawmill Museum Festival proudly announces the 16th Annual Arts and Crafts show and sale to be held at Kemper Williams Park, Hwy 90, Patterson, Louisiana on Friday, Saturday, and Sunday, March 31st, April 1st, and 2nd, 2006.

- ELIGIBILITY:** Open to all Crafters and Artists who sell their own QUALITY HAND CRAFT goods. No kits, Imports, molds (ceramics accepted), or Flea Market items. All applications will be screened and checked. No knives, stink bombs, swords, silly string, etc. Discretion of the Police Department.
- LOCATION:** Booth spaces will be marked in Kemper Williams Park as per requirements.
- FEE:** A space (approximately 10' x 10') will be provided for three days. The three day charge per space is \$100.00. The Festival does not provide tables, chairs, or other set-ups. If more than 10' width is required, additional booth (s) must be rented. No subletting of booth permitted.
- TAX:** All booth operators are required to have or apply for a Tax number for the State of Louisiana and the Parish of St. Mary.
- ELECTRICITY:** A limited number of electrical hook-ups are available. These will be assigned on a "First Come, First Serve" basis. There will be no charge for electricity to operate booths during these three days. Lighting and fans only! See agreement.
- SCHEDULE:** March 20, 2006 is the Registration Deadline.
Registration Fee has to be in by March 20, 2006 to retain booth from last year. No set-up until booth fee is paid.

PATTERSON CYPRESS SAWMILL MUSEUM FESTIVAL AGREEMENT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

This agreement is entered into between the Patterson Cypress Sawmill Museum, Inc., and the individual (or organization) identified below to allow participation in the 16th Annual Patterson Cypress Museum Festival to be held March 31st, April 1st and April 2nd at the Kemper Williams Park, Patterson, LA.

1. Arts & Crafts booth space will be provided to participants for a fee of \$100.00 per booth on a first come, first serve basis. All tables, chairs, and other set ups must be provided by the participant. Should you require more than 10' width, you must rent an extra booth. No subletting allowed. Booths not occupied by 9:00 A.M. on Saturday will revert to Festival. No refunds after March 28.
2. All booth operators and other Festival participants shall have or apply for a Louisiana and St. Mary Parish tax number.
3. The Patterson Cypress Sawmill Museum, Inc., will furnish 110 volt electrical hook-ups on a first come, first serve basis at no charge to participants in the Festival for booth lighting and fans only. Should electricity be required for air-condition, computers etc., an additional \$30.00 will be charged for the three (3) day weekend.
4. The Festival is to be held at Kemper Williams Park in Patterson, Louisiana. The use of the park grounds for the Festival is with the express permission of the Kemper Williams Park and is subject to its rules, regulations, guidance, and direction. This agreement, therefore, incorporates all such rules and regulations of the Kemper Williams Park as though copied and set forth herein in full. A copy of those rules and regulations can be obtained from Kemper Williams Park Office in Patterson, Louisiana.
5. No participant, or any employee, helper, agent, or servant of participant in this Festival shall, for any reason or on any basis, be considered an employee, agent, or servant of the Museum.
6. The Museum does not warrant the condition of the premises being used for this Festival, nor any of the tools, booths, equipment, wires, cables, lights, roads, facilities, signs, or security, all of which may be provided by either the Museum or others, and then only as an accommodation to those participants in the Festival.
7. As an express consideration of the acceptance by the Patterson Cypress Sawmill Museum, Inc., of this participant's request for participation in this Festival, the participant specifically agrees to protect, hold harmless, indemnify, and defend the Patterson Cypress Sawmill Museum, its officers, directors, members, employees, servants, agents, and volunteers from any and all liability occurring or arising out of participation in the Patterson Cypress Sawmill Museum Festival or any of its activities.

8. The Participant agrees that only quality hand crafted goods shall be offered for sale to the public. No kits, imports, molds (ceramic excepted), manufactured goods or flea market allowed. All crafts will be screened for display in booths and may be rejected in the sole discretion of the Museum with vendor asked to leave.
9. Participants shall obey all laws and ordinances of the State of Louisiana and the Parish of St. Mary.

Having read and understood the above paragraphs, this Agreement is executed by and between the parties listed below on this the _____ day of _____ 2006.
