

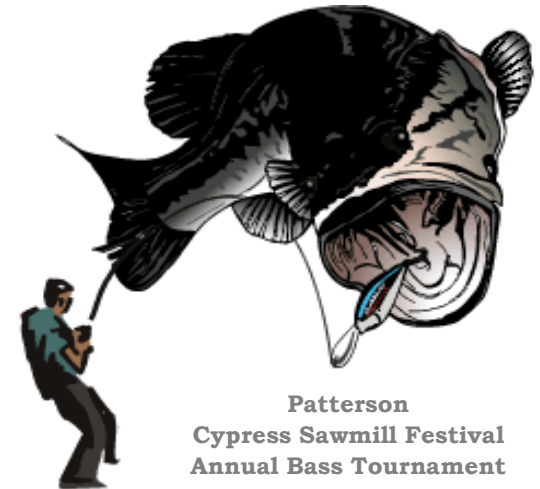

*by signing the above application, contestants release Cypress Sawmill Festival, Officials, and Sponsor's from liability of accidents, losses, and theft.*

1) These rules apply to all entrants of this tournament. Violation of any of these rules will warrant appropriate disciplinary action by the Tournament Director. Any protest must be received in writing and signed within fifteen minutes of check in deadline. Tournament Director decisions will be final in all matters.

2) State, Federal, and Local laws must be obeyed.  
3) Alcohol and/or Illegal Narcotics will not be allowed in the possession of contestants during tournament hours. Alcohol can be consumed after contestants have weighed in their days catch.

4) Courtesy, Safe Boating, Sportsmanship, and Conservation must be displayed at all times by contestants. A US Coast Guard approved PFD must be on and fastened anytime the combustion engine is running. All boats must be a minimum of 14' with a aerated livewell capable of maintaining their teams tournament catch alive and in good health. All boats must have an operational kill switch attached to the driver at all time engine is running. All boats must be propelled by an outboard motor. No mudboats! Boats must not exceed the manufacturers horsepower rating.

5) All fishing must be done with artificial lures only. Pork and attractants are permitted. Only one rod and reel may be used at a time. No trolling with the combustion engine at any time. All fish must be caught in a legal and sporting manner. Contestants may not use any communication or video device for the sole purpose of locating fish. Hole sitting by or for contestants is not allowed.

6) There will be no off limit periods prior to the start of the tournament.

7) Off limit areas are any areas not accessible by the general public such as Avoca Island, any posted and/or private property, or gated canals not open to all contestants.

8) Scoring will be based on (5) fish per team with a minimum length of 14 inches.

9) There will be a .2 lb penalty for any dead fish. Any fish smaller than 14 inches will be removed from the days catch and a (1) lb penalty will be assessed to the total weight.

10) Should there be any ties, they will be broken by the weight of the largest fish. However, if there still remains a tie, the prize money will be divided by the number of places tied.

11) \*All contestants must be checked in at the Berwick Landing by 3:00 pm. If contestant(s) are late their days catch will be disqualified. Late is late and will be determined by Tournament Directors designee. Contestants must make every attempt to traylor to the scales within a reasonable time. Scales will be subject to close at 3:45 if there are no contestants in the scale staging area.

12) Contestants cannot leave their boat in an effort to obtain fish. Jumping levees is not permitted.

13) All fish (except trophy bass) will become the property of the Cypress Sawmill Festival to be released upon completion of tournament.
